We are a grassroots organization giving continuity of service to people whose first language is not English. To help them to get to know the local community, understand their entitlements, know their rights and responsibilities to enable them to play a full part in the diverse Forth Valley Area.

We work towards justice, fair treatment and equality for all migrants and their families to help ensure that exploitation, racism and other abuses are avoided.

We operate a drop in service which is confidential and in a relaxed atmosphere. We research all new legislation. Social & Welfare justice of all economic migrant workers in the Forth Valley area is of paramount importance at F.M.S.



We make sure that we have all the facts and information required before contacting anyone on your behalf which speeds up services and cut costs to government agencies. Personal experience has taught us that wrong information from various agencies has impeded the settlement and integration of migrants from all nations.
